Vanaf bestuurskant begeef ons ons selde op finansiële terrein, aangesien ons daarop fokus om te onderrig en geleenthede te skep. Ongeag ander opinies is die terugvoer vanaf hoërskole dat ons van die beste op akademiese, sport- en kultuurgebied is en ver bo die norm uitstyg.

Ons uitslae spreek duidelik van ons prestasies en die waarde van dit wat ons aanbied. ‘n Mens kan geen finansiële waarde hieraan heg nie, MAAR volgens inligting wat ons ontvang, is dit duidelik dat ons waarde vir geld bied.

Ons moet egter vanaf bestuurskant meld dat 85% van ons ouers hul finansiële verpligtinge nakom, 10% hou by die reëlings en SLEGS 5% hou hulle stokdoof en kom glad nie hul finansiële verantwoordelikhede na nie. Gesinne wat uitdagings ervaar, maar by die reëlings hou en as ‘n saak van integriteit met ons saamwerk, stel werklik ‘n goeie voorbeeld. Om te sien dat ouers in die beste gastehuse tuisgaan, in weelderige restaurante eet en klere met bekende handelsmerke dra, MAAR weet dat hulle nie hul finansiële verpligtinge nakom nie, laat ‘n wrang smaak in die mond.

Baie dankie aan alle ouers wie se skoolfooie op datum is – en diegene wat nie hieronder tel nie, moet net weet dat dit nooit te laat is om die regte ding te doen nie.

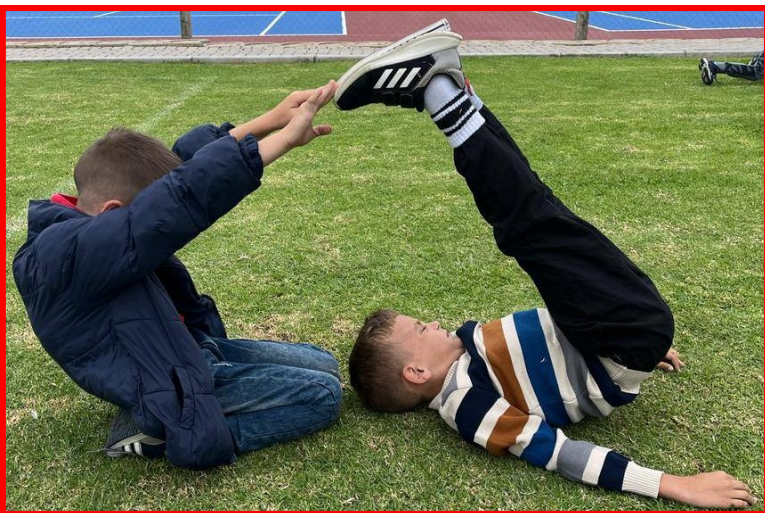
