Dear Parents

We are proud of all our learners as they grow and develop in all different areas of life during their years at Sunridge. Our core business remains academics and we take pride in our results over the years. Sport and cultural achievements speak for themselves and although these aspects are also supported by external input, we manage to bring them together very successfully. Not all children can perform on high levels be it academic, sport or culture but the social skills that are learned are worth way more than achieving 80% or playing in an A team.

Even though we must agree that we will sometimes disagree, this should always be with respect. Sunridge takes pride in the fact that all our learners pay school fees - we do not offer bursaries. It is our policy not to ask learners to come to Sunridge nor to offer anything - learners enroll at Sunridge of their own free will. It is only our own learners who participate and 99% of the time learners participate at Sunridge from the Foundation Phase until they reach our senior teams. This speaks volumes about our coaches.

It was a shock to learn how many primary schools' are "buying" players and recently even at under nine level. We condemn this practice - at any primary school level. We do not "buy" players and will take a stand against this. We distance ourselves from anyone who supports these practices and can assure you that we will not be a part of it.

Performing on all levels until you reach under 13 to find "bought players" from neighboring schools taking the place of learners who have carried the school from junior level leaves a bad taste in our mouths. Learners joining the school from outside the Metro or parents relocating is justified but "buying" in the Metro under the guise of creating opportunities cannot be condoned.

We create opportunities for Grade R learners to enroll at Sunridge, we welcome learners who relocate and then it is our task to develop and identify talent and create opportunities regardless of the team or level.

We hope that the above will shed light on our decision for the future, as our match regulations will change for 2026 . Thank you to all learners, parents and staff who keep to the high moral ground in all aspects of life.

Budget

Our proposed budget has been carefully prepared. The proposed school fees for 2026 will be R1900.00 per month. Again, a very conservative budget due to good financial support and practices. Our school is maintaining our resources and delivering a good service.

SGB Vacancies

With two vacancies coming up in 2026 we will be having our Bi-election on 13 October 2025. Currently Mrs Gerda-Mari Coverly and Mr Fritz Troskie serve as co-opted members with the relevant expertise and experience. Serving on the SGB does not reserve any additional rights nor privileges. This is a selfless service to assist and support management with certain responsibilities as governors and not managers.

Geagte Ouers

Ons is trots op al ons leerders terwyl hulle gedurende hul skoolloopbaan by Sunridge op al die verskillende vlakke van die lewe groei en ontwikkel. Akademie bly steeds ons vernaamste fokus en op hierdie gebied is ons trots op al ons uitslae oor die jare. Sport- en kultuurprestasies spreek boekdele en hoewel hierdie aspekte ook deur eksterne insette ondersteun word, slaag ons daarin om dit met groot sukses bymekaar te bring. Nie alle kinders kan op hoë vlakke presteer nie, hetsy akademies of op sport- of kultuurgebied, maar die sosiale vaardighede wat aangeleer word, is veel meer werd as om 80% te behaal of in die A-span te speel.

Hoewel ons moet saamstem dat ons soms van mekaar sal verskil, moet dit altyd met respek geskied. Sunridge is ook trots op die feit dat al ons leerders skoolfooie betaal – ons bied nie beurse aan nie. Dit is ons beleid om nie leerders te vra om by Sunridge aan te sluit nie en ons bied ook niks aan nie – leerders skryf by ons in uit eie vrye wil. Dit is slegs ons eie leerders wat deelneem en in 99% van alle gevalle is leerders vanaf grondslagfase by Sunridge ingeskryf, totdat hulle ons senior spanne bereik. Dit spreek boekdele oor ons afrigters.

Dit was 'n skok om te verneem hoeveel laerskole spelers “koop” – en onlangs selfs op onder nege-vlak. Ons keur hierdie praktyk af – op enige laerskoolvlak. Ons “koop” beslis nie spelers nie en sal ook daarteen weerstand bied. Ons distansieer onself van enigiens wat hierdie praktyke ondersteun en kan almal verseker dat ons nie deel daarvan sal wees nie.

Om op alle vlakke te presteer totdat jy die onder 13-ouderdomsgroep bereik en dan te vind dat “huurspelers” van buurskole die plek geneem het van leerders wat die skool vanaf junior vlak gedra het, laat 'n wrang smaak in die mond. Leerders wat van buite die metro by 'n skool aansluit of ouers wat verhuis, is geregverdig, maar om in die metro te “koop”, onder die dekmantel van die skep van geleenthede, kan nie goedgepraat word nie.

Ons skep geleenthede vir Gr R-leerders om by Sunridge in te skryf, ons verwelkom leerders wat verhuis en dan is dit ons taak om talent te identifiseer en te ontwikkel en geleenthede te skep, ongeag die span of vlak.

Ons hoop dat bogenoemde lig sal werp op ons besluit vir die toekoms, want ons wedstrydbepalings vir 2026 sal verander. Baie dankie aan alle leerders, ouers en personeel wat op alle vlakke by hul beginsels hou.

Begroting

Ons voorgestelde begroting is sorgvuldig voorberei. Die voorgestelde skoolfooie vir 2026 is R1 900 per maand – weereens 'n uiters konserwatiewe begroting a.g.v. goeie finansiële ondersteuning en praktyke. Ons skool hou ons bronne in stand en lewer 'n goeie diens.

Met twee vakatures in 2026, vind 'n tussenverkiesing op 13 Oktober 2025 plaas. Mev Gerda-Mari Coverly en mnr Fritz Troskie dien tans as gekoöpteerde lede, met relevante kundigheid en ervaring wat ons benodig. Dit is 'n onbaatsugtige diens om bestuur by te staan en te ondersteun met sekere verantwoordelikhede as goewerneurs en nie bestuurders nie.


