TENNIS: Reghardt van Zyl represented the EC at the Synergy Cup played in Cradock. The EC Elephants team came 2nd overall. **DANCE: Leeah Kleynhans** represented the EC at the Street Dance Association Dance Sport Club League Nationals.

KARATE: Mieke Jordaan was selected for the SA Development Karate team that competed in Botswana - she won gold medals for Kata and Kumite. Christopher Deale competed at the SA Karate Nationals - he won gold medals for Kata, Long Weapon and Unison Kata and silver for Short Weapon.

SQUASH: Garden Route Junior Open - **Janél Hall** won the u/15 age group and **Joshua Hall** was 3rd in the u/13 age group. **SOCCER: Sherzhaard Edinberry** (9) was awarded the trophy for the u/11 Player of the Tournament at the Caledonian FC Tournament.

TALENT AFRICA: Isabella and Gabriela Cumberlege received gold for their three eisteddfod items (prepared reading, undramatized poetry and public speaking) and platinum for their ballet. They have both qualified to represent SA at the Mediterranean Legends International Art Festival and Contest as well as for Dance Fest Novi Sad in 2026. Minke van Jaarsveld received Platinum for modeling for Fitness, Casual, Evening and swimwear. She has qualified to represent SA at the Mediterranean Legends International Art Festival and Contest. She will also compete in the Stars of the Universe competition.

EQUESTRIAN: South African Western Mounted Games Nationals: **Skyla Rae Seymour and Emily Rudman** represented the Eastern Cape - Skyla and her horse, Bilbo Bear, finished 2nd overall and are the SANESA Primary School Level 2 Reserve Champions 2025.
