Dear Parents

We humbly apologize to the vast majority of parents who comply with school rules and who respect our support staff, teachers and coaches. THANK YOU! THANK YOU!

Unfortunately some people do not abide by these. Parents interfere and disrupt school activities. It is common for instructions to be shouted to learners while the coach is busy. Making comments to learners and coaches and confronting coaches while they coach, is becoming a reality during practices and matches.

The rule is simple, do not disrupt or interfere - if you have something to say, put it in writing and send it to info@sunridge.co.za ***It is the only way!*** Unfortunately, this attitude and entitlement from a few parents now forces us to apply the regulations. Forcing a gate open to gain access to the school grounds, swearing at staff, interfering and disrupting school activities will now be dealt with by our security and legal team.

In the past we have allowed a concession to parents to access the grounds by not enforcing the regulations, but the result of the above behaviour requires us to withdraw these concessions.

For clarity refer to the following points: GN 10450 of 12 October 2001 as amended by the Government Gazette 29376 deal with Regulations for safety measures at public schools.

“4.(2) No person may— (f) cause any form of violence or disturbances which can negatively impact on any public-school activities;

8.(1) Parents have the right to visit the public school where their children have been admitted but such visits may not disrupt any of the school activities. 8.(2) Parents are required to make an appointment with the Principal of the school for a personal appointment with him or her prior to the visit and must state the reason for the visit and the persons who may be involved during the visit.”

9. (2) Any person who contravenes these regulations may be remove from the public-school premises.”

As I must approve any visit to the school, I have decided, after consultation with the SMT and SGB Executive, that until further notice parents do not have to make an appointment (8.2) to obtain permission to visit. They are permitted to attend sport practises or matches after school hours as long as they only enter after 14:10 and keep to the following rules:

1. Allow children to go their sport code at 14:00 and allow other children to leave first.
2. Parents may only sit on the pavilions.
3. No walking over the courts or fields of play and no one may stand next to the playing field.
4. No one may enter the school building, the swimming pool area is off limits and no one may stand in the walkways around the pool area to watch swimming.
5. The dance studio, any sport store, gymnasium and the Strelitzia are out of bounds.
6. Parent may use the gymnasium toilets.
7. Parents may visit the clothing and tuck shop if they are open.
8. If possible, a demarcated area may be made available for parents next to a field, court, etc. during matches.

No person is allowed on the school premises before 14:10 - the only exception is those who are there with the Principal's permission and are in possession of an official visitor's card. Parents who have appointments with staff must enter at the main gate and obtain a visitor's card.

Ons vra nederig om verskoning aan die oorgrote meerderheid van ouers wat die skoolreëls nakom en ons ondersteuningspersoneel, onderwysers en afrigters respekteer. DUISEND MAAL DANKIE!

Dit is ongelukkig so dat sommige mense hulle nie hieraan steur nie. Ouers meng in en ontwig skoolaktiwiteite.

Dit is algemeen dat opdragte aan leerders geskree word terwyl die afrigter besig is. Aanmerkings teenoor leerders en afrigters en om afrigters te konfronteer terwyl hulle werk, word 'n realiteit gedurende oefeninge en wedstryde.

Die reël is eenvoudig – moenie ontwig of inmeng nie. Indien u iets wil sê, stel dit op skrif en stuur na info@sunridge.co.za. Dit is die enigste manier! Ongelukkig verplig hierdie ingesteldheid en eiegeregtheid van 'n paar ouers ons om die regulasies toe te pas. Om 'n hek oop te forseer om sodoende toegang tot die skoolterrein te kry, om op personeel te vloek, met skoolaktiwiteite in te meng en dit te ontwig, sal voortaan deur ons sekuriteits- en regsplan hanteer word.

In die verlede het ons ouers toegang tot die terrein verleen deur nie die regulasies streng toe te pas nie, maar as gevolg van bogenoemde gedrag sal ons verplig word om hierdie toewysing te herroep.

Vir duidelikheid kan na die volgende punte verwys word: GN 10450 van 12 Oktober 2001, soos gewysig in Staatskoerant 29376 handel oor Regulasies vir veiligheidsmaatreëls by openbare skole.

“4. (2) Geen persoon mag— (f) enige vorm van geweld of rusverstoring veroorsaak wat 'n negatiewe invloed op openbare skoolaktiwiteite kan hê nie;

8. (1) Ouers het die reg om die openbare skool wat deur hul kinders bygewoon word, te besoek, maar sodanige besoeke mag geen skoolaktiwiteite ontwig nie. 8.(2) Ouers moet voor die besoek 'n afspraak vir 'n persoonlike onderhoud met die Skoolhoof reël en moet die rede vir die besoek verstrek, asook diegene wat gedurende die besoek betrokke mag wees.

9. (2) Enige persoon wat hierdie reëls oortree, mag van die openbare skoolterrein verwyder word.”

Aangesien ek enige besoek aan die skool moet goedkeur, het ek, ná konsultasie met die SBS en SBL besluit dat ouers, tot verdere kennisgewing, nie 'n afspraak hoef te reël (8.2) om toestemming te verkry om die skool te besoek nie. Hulle mag sportoefeninge of -wedstryde ná skoolure bywoon indien hulle die skoolterrein ná 14:10 binnekom en die volgende reëls nakom:

1. Kinders toelaat om na hul sportkode te beweeg om 14:00 en ander kinders toelaat om eers uit te gaan.
2. Ouers mag slegs op die pawiljoen sit.
3. Daar mag nie oor die bane of velde gestap word nie en niemand mag langs die speelveld staan nie.
4. Niemand mag die skoolgebou binnekom nie, die swembadarea is buite perke en niemand mag op die looppaadjies rondom die swembad staan en kyk hoe die kinders swem nie.
5. Die dansateljee, enige sportstoorkamer, gimnasium en Strelitzia is buite perke.
6. Ouers mag die toilette in die gimnasium gebruik.
7. Ouers mag die klerewinkel en snoepie besoek as dit oop is.
8. Indien moontlik, kan 'n afgebakende ruimte vir ouers langs 'n veld of baan, ens. gedurende wedstryde beskikbaar gestel word
